ALL STUDENTS MUST COMPLY WITH THIS CODE

TOPS	<p>All Years - BLC black polo top (with logo).</p> <p>Reception to year 6 - red sweatshirt (with BLC logo).</p> <p>Years 7 to 9 – Black sweatshirt (with BLC logo).</p> <p>Year 10 and 11 – Black Sweatshirt (with BLC logo).</p> <p>During the Summer Term, Primary Students are allowed to wear Gingham dresses.</p> <p>No undergarments, e.g.: t-shirts, vests, long sleeved tops, etc.</p>
TROUSERS AND SKIRTS	<p>Black school trousers or School skirt of a respectable length, with a skirt, black tights should be worn at all times. NO jeans.</p>
PE KIT	<p>T-shirt and shorts. Can be any colour – but not a football shirt or a t-shirt which could cause offence. Pupils can either wear black pumps or trainers. A change of socks is desirable.</p>
FOOTWEAR	<p>KS1 & KS2 pupils – black plimsolls (pumps) – to be changed into at the start of the day. KS3 & KS4 pupils – BLACK School shoes only – NO OTHER COLOUR.</p> <p>Trainers will be needed for some pupils for PE lessons.</p>
HEADWEAR	<p>No hats of any description to be worn in School.</p> <p>No bandanas.</p> <p>Hair bands may be worn.</p>
COATS	<p>Jackets and coats must only be worn as an outer layer and are not to be worn inside the school building or classrooms. Hooded sweaters are not allowed.</p>
JEWELLERY	<p>No jewellery – except one pair of small ear studs. All other jewellery will need to be removed at the start of the day and put into pupil's property bags until the end of the day. This will be at the pupils own risk, so it would be sensible for NO jewellery to be worn at all.</p>
